The Chairman extended a very warm welcome to all the members of the Board and thanked them for sparing their valuable time out of their busy schedule to attend this meeting of the Board. The Chairman also conveyed his greetings for holding the second meeting of the BOG in TSSOT. The Chairman also introduced Prof. Souvik Bhattacharyya, Department of Mechanical Engineering and Deputy Director, IIT Kharagpur and Prof. Hafizur Rahaman, Department of Information Technology, IIEST, Shibpur to all the members of the Board of Governors and expressed his sincere thanks to all of them for attending the meeting as Members of BOG in TSSOT, AUS.

The Chairman informed the members about the sad demise of Prof. Ramendu Bhattacharjee, Pro Vice-Chancellor of Assam University, Silchar and a former Dean of the Triguna Sen School of Technology. The members expressed condolences and one minute silence was observed praying for eternal peace of the departed soul of Prof. Ramendu Bhattacharjee who expired prematurely.

The Chairman then invited the Dean, TSSOT who is the Member-Secretary of BOG to initiate discussions on the agenda items.

After threadbare discussions the following resolutions were adopted unanimously.

### **AGENDA AND RESOLUTIONS:**

## AGENDA NO. 2.1: CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE 1<sup>st</sup> MEETING OF THE BOG OF TSSOT.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.1:** Since no comment has been received from the members, the Board confirmed the minutes of the 1<sup>st</sup> Meeting of the BOG of Triguna Sen School of Technology (TSSOT) held on 28<sup>th</sup> January, 2015.

AGENDA NO. 2.2: DETAILED PROJECT REPORT (DPR)

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.2:** The Member-Secretary appraised the members about the proposed DPR of the school. After in-depth discussion the following are resolved unanimously.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.2.1:** The members have an in-depth discussion on the name of the School and it is unanimously resolved that TSSOT should be renamed as Assam University Institute of Technology (AU-IT) as the proposed structure and activities of the school are more of an Institute than a school. Thus from now onwards all the places wherever needed TSSOT will be renamed as AU-IT. After changing the name, it should be forwarded to AICTE and other relevant agencies for approval.

The Registrar of Assam University is asked to place it in EC and to take necessary measurements for implementation.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.2.2:** The members have a prolonged discussion on the proposed DPR of AU-IT and certain modifications are suggested for the DPR. The Chairman, NBA preparation committee will incorporate all changes and will circulate it to all members for approval or will be placed in the next BOG meeting.

The Registrar of Assam University is asked to place it in EC and to take necessary measurements to implement the DPR of AU-IT.

#### AGENDA NO. 2.3: STATUS REPORT ON TEQIP-II - REG.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.3:** The Co-ordinator, TEQIP-II had reported the members about the TEQIP-II activities executed following the Institutional Development Proposal (IDP), Project Implementation Plan (PIP) and with the approval of the competent authority. The Co-ordinator, TEQIP-II had appraised the members about the 4<sup>th</sup> JRM report where four implementation indicators were found falling short. After thread bare discussion the following resolutions were considered unanimously

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.3.1:** The minute of the first BOG meeting will be uploaded in the university website as it is now confirmed. This will met one short-fall.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.3.2:** All the eligible programmes for NBA accreditation will be processed immediately. The Chairman of the NBA preparation committee is requested to take necessary initiative to complete the process of accreditation.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.3.3:** The Co-ordinator, TEQIP-II is requested to complete the updation in the MIS software immediately with the help of the staff of the TEQIP Cell.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.3.4:** The Co-ordinator, TEQIP-II is requested to prepare the action plan for the rest of the project period (upto October, 2016) for the commitment for expenditure of the unspent fund available and the balance allocation yet to be received immediately. The Chairman, BOG is authorised to approve the action plan.

#### AGENDA NO. 2.4: PROPOSED CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (CBCS).

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.4**: The Member-Secretary briefed the members about the necessity of the new CBCS as guided by UGC and AICTE in the joint workshop held at Guwahati on 27 Mar, 2015. He also placed the related resolution of the minute of the School Board of TSSOT held on 23 Mar, 2015. After thorough discussion, the members approved the minute of School Board and advised Dean, TSSOT to arrange a workshop at the School level to finalise the CBCS structure. The members also opioned that the proposed structure will be implemented from 2015-16 academic year. The Chairman is authorised to approve the proposed CBCS structure of AU-IT so that it may be implemented from the academic session 2015-16.

#### AGENDA NO. 2.5: NEW ACADEMIC CALENDAR.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.5**: The Member-Secretary briefed the members about the necessity of the new Academic Calendar for AU-IT and placed the academic calendar and holiday list for AU-IT. After thorough discussion, the members on principle agreed on the proposals and requested the Chairman of BOG to place it in the Executive Council meeting of the university for approval. The academic

calendar and holiday list for AU-IT is attached as Annexure I. Relating to this, the members also resoluted the following:

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.5.1:** The Examination process of AU-IT will be autonomous and Dean(Academic) of AU-IT will be Examination in-charge of AU-IT.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.5.2:** The theory examination schedule will be prepared clubbing 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> years in one half and 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> years in another half. The laboratory examinations will be conducted in the last week of the lab session.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.5.3:** To follow the continuous evaluation process, the full mark of each paper will be distributed in three categories:

- i) Internal assessment 20 marks (will be spread over the entire semester)
- ii) Mid-semester examination 30 marks
- iii) End-semester examination 50 marks

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.5.4:** To be promoted to 3rd year a student has to clear all the courses of 1st year and to be promoted to 4th year a student has to clear all the courses of 2nd year.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.5.5:** The checking/evaluation of the answer scripts have to be completed before vacation and the evaluated answer scripts will be shown to the students during a fixed period of time. The result will be published within 6 weeks from the completion of examination.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.5.6:** The summer internship will be of 8-10 weeks. The classes and the examninations have to be scheduled accordingly.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.5.7:** AU-IT will remain open from 9:00 am to 5:30 pm with 30 minutes lunch break and 5 working days will be there in a week. Proper transportation facility should be there for the students and the faculties and staff for the new office hours.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.5.8:** Tech fest will be organised every year starting from 5:00 pm in any Friday and will be completed by Sunday night. Monday will be the working day as usual.

#### AGENDA NO. 2.6: MISCELLANEOUS

### AGENDA NO. 2.6.1: IDENTIFICATION OF THE THRUST AREAS FOR INDIVIDUAL DEPARTMENTS:

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.6.1:** It is resolved that individual departments will prepare their Vision and Mission in the line of the Vision and Mission of AU-IT where the thrust areas or focused areas of the department will be reflected. The concerned Head of the department will organize discussions within the department to identify the thrust areas and finalise it. The final report should be submitted within next six months.

The curriculum of the department will be designed depending on the thrust areas.

### AGENDA NO. 2.6.2: THINKERING LAB, REG.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.6.2:** It is resolved that at the institute level a new conceptual lab space named as <u>"Thinkering Lab"</u> will be established and will be kept open for the students on 24x7 basis. The lab space will be used by the interested students who want to devote their extra time in innovation or thinking and nurturing the new ideas. The logistic supports will be provided by the departments and AU-IT.

#### AGENDA NO. 2.6.3: INDUSTRY SPONSORED STUDENT PROJECTS

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.6.3:** It is resolved that the departments will emphasize on the collaboration with the industry to start the industry sponsored undergraduate projects for which a maximum of five students may be grouped for individual departments. Also, a interdisciplinary group may be formed taking students from more than one group for the need of the project.

### AGENDA NO. 2.6.4: INCLUSION OF AN EXPERT OF AGRICULTURAL ENGINEERING IN BOG

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.6.4:** It is resolved that an eminent expert from the field of Agricultural Engineering will be included in BOG of AU-IT. The Head of the department will forward the name to the Chairman of BOG and the Chairman is authorised to approve the name of the expert as a member of BOG.

### AGENDA NO. 2.6.5: DOCTORAL PROGRAMME IN THE DEPARTMENT OF ELECTRONICS AND COMMUNICATION ENGINEERING

**RESOLUTION NO. 2.6.4:** It is resolved that the Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering will start the Doctoral programme (PhD) from the academic session 2015-16 as the eligible supervisor is available in the department. It will help to promote the research activities in the department.
