The format for paper submission

- Full Length Paper: 4000-8000 words
- Paper Title should be brief
- All authors Title (e.g. Dr/Mr/Mrs) and Name, Affiliation, Email etc
- Abstract not more than 250-300 words and 5 Keywords
- Theoretical Paper include (Abstract, keywords, Introduction, Conceptual framework, conclusion, references)
- Empirical Paper include (Abstract, keywords, Introduction, Conceptual framework, literature review, methodology, results and discussions, conclusion, references)
- References : APA 7th Edition
- Margin : 1 inch (all sides)
- Font: Times New Roman, (12 size), A4 size
- Line spacing : 1.5 between lines

Papers are invited from the above mentioned themes from Teacher educators, Academicians, professionals, administrators, policy makers, research scholars, school teachers, trainee teachers and students from colleges and universities.

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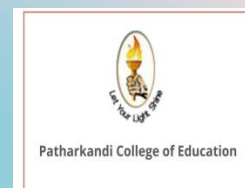

About the University

Assam University came into existence in 1994 after enactment of the Assam (Central) University Act 1989. Through its pursuit, Assam University is in the process of making itself an institute of excellence.

Our Department is one among the few others in our country where the entrants can develop them only after their schooling by opting integrated B.Sc.B.Ed. Programme.

About the College

Patharkandi College of Education was established in 1995 with the bold, sincere, dedicated and determined efforts of the people of this remote and landlocked region of Southern Assam under the vigorous leadership of Late Prof. Quomrul Hoque. About the Seminar

The global educational development agenda reflected in the Goal 4 (SDG4) of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, adopted by India in 2015 seeks to "ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all by 2030. Such a lofty goal will require the entire education system to be reconfigured to support and foster learning, so that all of the critical targets and goals (SDGs) of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development can be achieved. In this direction the Government of India took so many initiatives to revamp the Indian education system like RTE Act, 2009, PMMNMTT (2014-15), SMSA (2018-19), NEP 2020 etc. The Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act, 2009, which represents the consequential legislation, ensures that every child has a right to full-time elementary education of satisfactory and equitable quality in a formal school that satisfies certain essential norms and standards. Article 21-A and the RTE Act came into effect on 1 April 2010. Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan (SMSA) is integrated scheme for school education extending from pre-school to class-XII (3 to 18 years age group). It treats school education holistically without segmentation from pre-nursery to class-XII.

National Education Policy 2020 is the first education policy of the 21st century and aims to address the many growing developmental imperatives of our country. This Policy proposes the revision and revamping of all aspects of the education structure, including its regulation and governance, to create a new system that is aligned with the aspirational goals of 21st-century education, including SDG4, while building upon India's traditions and value systems.

Teacher education, ideally in terms of its relevance and importance, occupies an important place in the education system as it equips people with their employment. Hence skill development is thrust for today's education system from elementary to university system. The quality of teaching lies in teacher education and the process of teacher preparation. According to national education policy 2020, teacher education is vital in creating a pool of school teachers that will shape the next generation. Teacher preparation is an activity that requires multidisciplinary

perspectives and knowledge, formation of dispositions and values, and development of practice under the best mentors. Teacher education must undergo a paradigm shift. In this respect what will be the role of appropriate knowledge and skills for teacher and teacher educators i.e. teacher education as a whole? It is a matter of discourse analysis, which is going on throughout country. This seminar "**Professional Development of Teachers in the Present Scenario**" will focus on ways and means of teacher preparation process. In this context, this seminar aims to share views and ideas about new possibilities of delivering education.
