NOTIFICATION

On the recommendation of University Admission Committee and as approved by the Vice Chancellor, it is notified for information of all concerned that the following guidelines will be followed for admission to UG/IG courses being offered by Assam University for the session 2022-23.

1. The following schedule has been fixed for UG/IG admission 2022, which may kindly be adhered to strictly by all concerned.

Date of opening of admission portal for submission of online application	16 th September, 2022
Last date of submission of online application	14 th October, 2022
Approval of online applications by the departments	18 th October, 2022
Date of declaration of list of selected candidates in Assam University Admission Portal	27 th October, 2022
Dates of admission of selected candidates to UG/IG Courses including of payment of fess	28 th to 31 st October, 2022
Publication of second list of selected candidates if any	08 th November, 2022
Payment of fees by the candidates from second list	8 th -11 th November, 2022
Commencement classes for UG/IG Courses	1 st November, 2022

2. Assam University will not conduct any entrance test for admission to UG/IG Courses. The candidates who have qualified CUET (UG), 2022 conducted by NTA and have scores for different subjects as specified for respective UG/IG Course(s) only may apply online on payment of Rs.1000/- for General and OBC students, Rs.900/-for OBC (NCL)/EWS category and Rs.800/ for SC/ST/PWD candidates through payment gateway system.
3. The web link for online application is <https://www.ausexamination.ac.in/admission/>
4. HoDs / Admission Coordinators of the respective academic department should check and approve the applications by using login credentials of his/her departments. If there is any problem in this regard concerned HoD may contact Mr. Sobhan Kumar Bedjna, System Analyst, CoE Office. In the absence of any regular HoD because of Puja vacation or any other reason, HoD i/c may be authorized to check and approve/reject applications for admission.
5. While according approval, the following matters need to be verified:
 - (a) Whether the applicant has entered CUET (UG), 2022 percentile score and normalized score of all five subjects.
 - (b) Whether the subjects mentioned in the online application are as per eligibility criteria of the department.

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- (c) If the subjects and scores mentioned in the application are correct as per uploaded CUET (UG) Score sheet.
 - (d) Whether the 10+2 and HSLC percentage mentioned in the application are as per mark sheet uploaded by the candidate.
 - (e) If the candidate satisfies other eligibility criteria set by the department.
 - (f) Whether the OBC-NCL certificate is as per GOI format and is valid. Alternatively the candidate should be treated as UR category.
 - (g) If the other category certificate such as SC/ST/EWS/PWD is correct.
6. In case of rejection of application(s) comments/remarks should be given in the text box as 'Does not fulfill eligibility criteria'.
 7. In order to avoid last moment rush in approving the applications, the concerned HoD/ Admission coordinator may approve the applications regularly even on daily basis.
 8. A students can apply maximum in two courses, if he/she posses CUET (UG), scores of the relevant subjects for eligibility for admission to the courses of choice. However, he/she has to apply separately depositing requisite application fee.
 9. For preparing the merit list the average of percentile score/ normalized score of all five subjects is to be calculated for selection of candidate for a particular course.
 10. Reservation Policy of GoI is to be strictly followed in the admission of students for various courses.
