In pursuance to the decision of 92<sup>nd</sup> Academic Council meeting vide resolution no. AC:92:11-12:20.6 held on 18-11-2022 and subsequent approval by the 153<sup>rd</sup> Executive Council meeting vide resolution no. EC:153:11-12:14 held on 22-11-2022, the assessment scheme of the theory papers under B.Tech and M.Tech courses of Triguna Sen School of Technology (TSSOT) has been revised. With the adoption of the revised assessment scheme, the existing pattern, i.e., Sessional Test (20 marks), Mid-Term Examination (30 marks), and End-Term Examination (50 marks) is replaced with the revised pattern: Sessional Test (30 marks) and End-Term Examination (70 marks) with no Mid-Term examination.

The qualifying marks for each Test / Examination shall be 40% of the total marks, i.e., 12 marks for Sessional Test, and 28 marks for End-Term Examination with all other provisions being similar to that of the present PG programs in other departments.

The modified assessment scheme will be applicable to both B.Tech and M.Tech courses students and shall be effective from the new batch of students admitted in 2022.
